Background

- CCPR Comparison Analysis Workshop, 2015
 - Identified absence of guidelines on use of comparison results in CMC review
 - Establish Discussion Group
 - Workshop during CCPR week
- During formation of Discussion Group
 - More urgent issues with CMC review identified
 - Topic of workshop changed

Two Discussion Topics

- Current issues in CMC review process
 - Inter-regional review mechanisms
 - CMC claims not supported by comparisons
- Philosophy of CMCs and service categories
 - Historical perspective
 - Recommendations from the MRA review
 - Possible issues associated with changes
- Recommendations

- Inter-regional review mechanisms
 - Preventing CMCs which need extended time for acceptance from delaying rest of a submission
 - Breaking up large CMC submissions
- CMC claims not supported by comparisons
 - Moved to WG-CMC meeting

- Historical perspective on service categories
 - CMC review is the formal mechanism for NMIs to review each other's capability, allowing mutual recognition of calibration certificates
 - CMCs should focus on underpinning quantities, giving broad information about an NMI's capabilities, but should go beyond KC results to some extent
 - Only Category 1 quantities included originally

- Recommendations of the MRA review
 - CMCs should become representative rather than comprehensive
 - CMCs "are tools for describing the capabilities maintained to underpin delivery of those services"

- Possible issues associated with changes
 - Emerging NMIs may not implement underpinning quantities i.e. a barrier to entry
 - The objective quality assurance provided by CMCs may be more important to emerging NMIs
 - Clients in some areas expect a high level of detail in CMCs
 - Accreditation bodies require associated NMI services to be backed by CMCs

- EURAMET proposal re WG-CMC structure
 - Formal membership unchanged
 - Establish TG on harmonisation of procedures
 - Membership
 - Meetings
