Case 1 Ericsson

Ericsson, the world-leading company providing services, software and infrastructure especially in mobility, broadband and the cloud - are enabling the communications industry and

China has always been one of the most important markets of Ericsson for many years. In 2002,

China became a global supply center of Ericsson out of three centers, the R&D investment in

From 2001, the National Institute of Metrology (NIM) officially became the calibration service

provider for Ericsson, annually reviewed by ISO 17025. Ericsson fully accepted the calibration

service and certificates issued by NIM based on the CMCs recognized by the CIPM MRA.

NIM provides on-site and on-line calibration for Ericsson based on the particular needs of

clients from communication sector. The services include: technical consulting, calibration, maintenance, training, etc. As of 2014, NIM has issued nearly 30000 calibration certificates for

Ericsson, created significant economic benefit by avoiding tracing to other countries.

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
