The Headquarters of the future is a centre of scientific excellence with expertise and services that assists multi-disciplinary teams addressing global measurement challenges and coordinate the development of accurate measurement in the world at large.

Ongoing priorities

- ◆ Maintain scientific expertise required for the effective coordination of CIPM MRA activities, including the Key Comparison Database (KCDB) and high-impact comparisons.
- ◆ Coordinate UTC; support the global community of UTC laboratories and promote its uptake with users.
- ◆ Liaise with priority International Organizations (IOs) to promote metrology solutions to grand challenges and to facilitate access for NMIs to their international stakeholders.
- ◆ Expand Capacity Building and Knowledge Transfer and e-learning activities, in partnership with the RMOs.

Expanding role

- ◆ Coordinate sectorial activities and particularly those that are co-funded by other IOs.
- ◆ Facilitate online participation to provide fair access to meetings and resources to all Member States.
- ◆ Coordinate and implement new digital services including new services to provide the SI Reference Point.
- ◆ Use new digital tools to facilitate equitable access across all NMIs and regions.
- ◆ Promote the “Observer” model for states and IOs to increase global participation.

Improve efficiency

- ◆ Balance staff skills to best address future priority requirements.
- ◆ Redirected resources to address growing future commitments to digital transformation.
- ◆ Access external facilities to achieve greater efficiency.
- ◆ Leverage established partner networks to minimize the need for routine services at the BIPM Headquarters.
