


Changes in the JCRB CMC review process and website


Changes have been made according to the Resolution 30/1 of the 30th JCRB meeting, based on discussions from best practices workshop

Please be aware, that:

- The deadline to indicate intention to review 3 weeks (with a reminder 1 week before the deadline);
- The deadline chosen by RMO for submission its review report the date you indicate is a hard deadline (with a reminder 3 weeks before the deadline);
- The deadline for approval of CMCs 3 weeks (with a reminder 1 week before the deadline).




Pay attention to review deadlines to avoid loss-of-rights





Loss of rights for AUV CMC inter-RMO reviews

Action 31/1: BIPM to develop an electronic format for the form "Key and supplementary comparison registration form" in order to improve the accuracy and consistency of the information relating to KC status on the KCDB.

Action 32/1: Minor revision to format

Reports of Comparisons involving non-signatories of the CIPM MRA

Resolution 34/1: The policy for reporting comparisons that involve non-signatories of the CIPM MRA is clarified according to the following text:

"Measurement comparison reports should be written to reflect the experiment that was actually performed, including summary results from all participants. These reports should be accessible from the online Key Comparison Database, but the graphs and tables of equivalence explicitly shown should include results only from signatory NMIs and DIs."

New RMO: GULFMET



CIPM/104-38 (October 2015)

The CIPM granted provisional acceptance of GULFMET as a Regional Metrology Organization (RMO) in accordance with the procedures of the JCRB and within the meaning of the CIPM MRA.

Egypt, Turkey, Korea, Hong Kong, and Bosnia & Herzegovina are associate GULFMET members

- Provisional acceptance means participation in JCRB meetings and CMC reviews with a voice but without a vote
- CMC submission only after achieving full member status
- CMC review of other RMOs with vote only after publishing their CMCs
- CMC submission will require participation in comparisons




