- An MRA Review Workshop was convened, 13 14 October 2015
- Workshop attendees included NMI Directors, representatives of Member States, representatives of RMOs and other relevant stakeholders
- Workshop appointed the Working Group on the Implementation and Operation of the CIPM MRA (finally 19 + 3 invitees)
- Four Sub-Group identified to consider specific questions posed by the Workshop
- Working Group met formally at BIPM on 14 15 March 2016
- Report prepared and sent to NMI Directors for comment on 2 June 2016
- Final Report 23 August 2016
- 28 Recommendations and sub-recommendations, 13 involving specific actions for CCs
- This presentation summarizes the specific actions identified for CCs
