Dosimetry – The CSIR–NML has 1 CMC submission in Appendix C.

Radioactivity – The CSIR–NML has **36** CMC submissions in Appendix C. These were the **first** radioactivity CMCs placed into the database, after being approved by COOMET, SIM and EUROMET reviewers.

Key comparisons:

Dosimetry – The CSIR–NML participated in the regional comparison of absorbed dose to water for ⁶⁰Co, organised by the APMP in 2000–2001.
