The CIPM Mutual Recognition Arrangement (CIPM MRA) is the framework through which National Metrology Institutes demonstrate the international equivalence of their measurement standards and the calibration and measurement certificates they issue.

There are 250 institutes participating in the CIPM MRA, comprising 97 NMIs, 4 international organizations and 149 designated institutes.

Inclusivity: Gulf Organization for Metrology (GULFMET) now an RMO with full rights, all regions of the world are now covered.

Efficiency and effectiveness:

- CIPM MRA documentation consolidated into a suite of six policy and guideline documents.
- CMC review durations reduced to less than 100 days (median).
- Key comparison completion delays halved compared with historical performance.
- Strongly supported by the Capacity Building and Knowledge Transfer programme training.

Communication:

A suite of CIPM MRA brochures has been released to explain and highlight the CIPM MRA, its mechanisms, and key players.

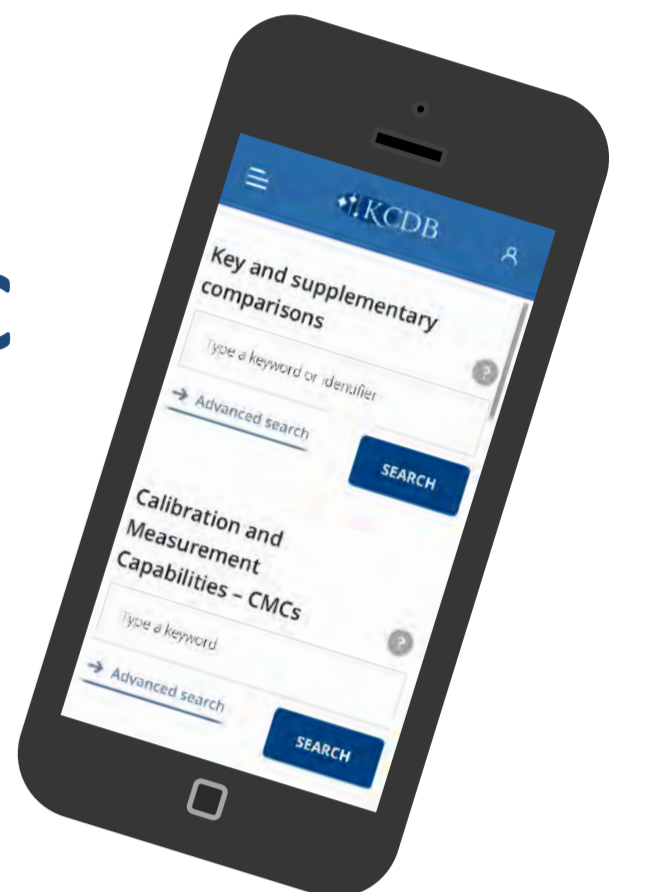


KCDB

In October 2019, a new version of the KCDB was launched.

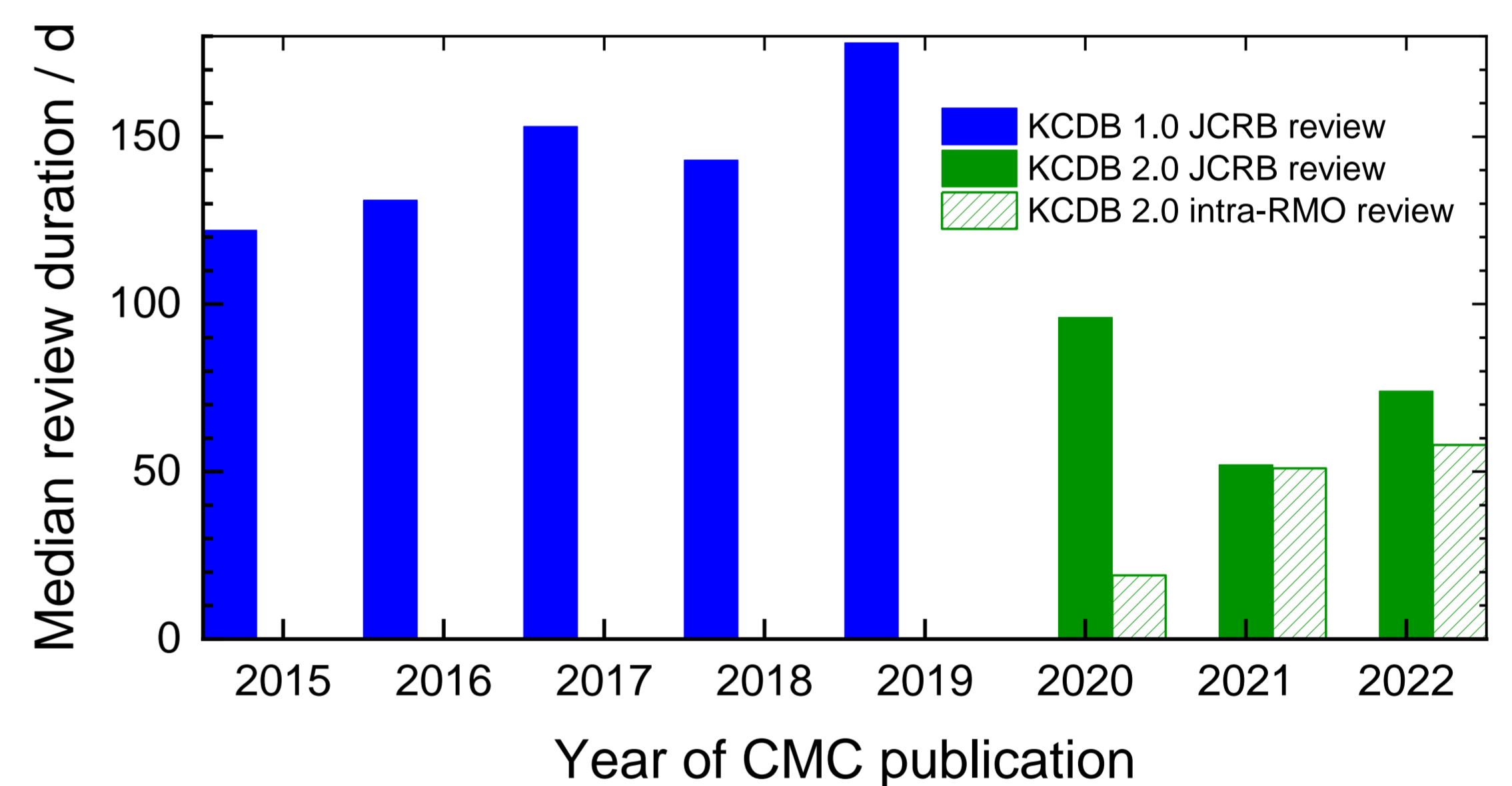
It provides:

- an interactive single platform for CMC submission, review and publication
- improved search facilities
- a tailored statistical tool



A newly developed Application Programming Interface (API) for the KCDB provides the first steps towards machine-readable CMC data.

The new support has contributed to the reduced CMC review duration and publication delay.
